Activities definitely include, but not restricted to:

All aspects of Zone 1 gardening including nursery work, plant propagation, planting, fertilizer making and application, mulching, and weeding.

In the kitchen will be helping out with meals, produce processing and value adding, helping out with catering for workshops.

Assisting with our administration requirements; Website development, facebook updating and possible Mackay Community Garden support.
